Local Softball Associations gearing up to host another season of High School Feeder League Softball

Kirkwood Athletic Association (KAA) and St. Charles County Softball Association (SCCSA) are thrilled to be co-hosting another great season of High School Feeder League Softball, with opening day planned for August 2018. This will be the 12th year for the St. Charles County League and the 4th for schools in the St Louis/Jefferson County areas.

The purpose of this announcement is to reinforce the value of this league, and to encourage your support, within the stated MSHSAA rules, should a potential Coach contact you about plans to field a team. Additionally, if you know an individual in your district interested in starting a team please direct them to contact Marilyn McCarthy for more information.

The Feeder League is designed to provide middle school athletes a competitive and structured league, umpired by trained USA Softball umpires. Our objective is to expand and develop softball in the area and provide new and experienced players with opportunities to learn and work on their fundamentals so they can pursue playing some level of high school ball, should they decide to do so. Additionally these students love the opportunity to represent their communities and meet future classmates and potentially future HS teammates.

The teams are led by volunteer coaches, primarily parents, and are assembled through a combination of postings in the middle schools, electronic flyers shared through the school district's communication platforms and word of mouth. In 2017, twenty-three 6/7th grade teams and twenty-four 8th grade teams competed in the combined leagues with more than 650 athletes suiting up to represent a total of twenty-six (26) High Schools.

1. Provide approval to post Flyers in your district's middle schools
2. Distribute an electronic flyer through your district's middle school parent email system
3. Provide access for the teams to schedule practice fields at your district's facilities
