



# 2017 High School Feeder League

- A structured, positive and competitive softball environment designed to promote skill development, provide opportunities to play for your school, experience live game situations & good sportsmanship
- Two Grade Divisions **6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> Grade** **8<sup>th</sup> Grade**
- **10-game Sunday-league plus end of season tournament**
  - Season kicks off Sunday August 27<sup>th</sup>; runs through Sunday October 1<sup>st</sup>
    - Feeder League will not conflict with KAA Fall Ball league schedule
  - End of Season Tournament, with St Charles County Teams, on Saturday Oct. 7<sup>th</sup> & Sunday Oct. 8<sup>th</sup>
- **\$950 League Fee due Friday August 4<sup>th</sup>**
  - League fee includes Team Liability & Secondary Medical Insurance

## Feeder League Guidelines & Top Line Rules

- We expect participants (coaches & players) to honor the game by knowing the playing rules
- Player Eligibility Requirements
  - Players must live in the district, or be eligible to attend the represented high school
  - Players can be double-rostered on their District's feeder teams BUT a player can only play up on the higher-grade level team, older players are not permitted to play on the lower grade level team
  - Roster exemptions requests will be considered. Up to a maximum of 3 exemptions/team can be requested for approval
    - Districts with multiple teams at one grade level can submit up to a maximum of 2 roster exemptions requests
    - Small district schools can connect with other small district schools and request to form one multi-district team
- Teams must bat the roster for all league games
- Teams must provide 1 new/like new game ball for every game
