Plans for 2021 Season

RIGHT NOW, our plans are to begin league play the week of May 3, 2021. We realize that is a month later than usual, however, by delaying a month, we are hoping to maximize chances for people to get vaccinated and for warmer weather to kick in to minimize Covid-19 complications.

Games will be played on Wednesday and Thursday evenings. We will play double headers where possible in order to minimize people at the park. We will also be spacing out game times and alternating field usage for the same reason. Most importantly, we are increasing our league schedule to 12 games, up from 10, this year at no additional cost!

2021 KAA Spring/Summer League

Registration Fee:

\$500 Non-refundable deposit due April 1, 2021(Secures spot in league)

+ \$600 Balance due April 15, 2021

\$1100 Total league fee.

League Fee includes:

- 12 league games 6u, 8u, 10u, 12u, 14u, 16u, 18u, Premier
- Free entry into one 2021 KAA house tournament in lieu of league rainout makeups
- The intention of the free KAA house tournament is to offset league games lost during the season due to inclement weather.
- Total games possible with league and the free tournament is 14+.
- The free tournament offering is <u>only redeemable in the same calendar year</u>, and cannot be transferred to the following season but may be transferred to another team in the same organization.
- ONLY KAA house tournaments may be designated as a free league tournament. USA/NSA/USSSA/Perfect Game sanctioned events do not apply.
- In the event the free league tournament chosen is cancelled, another KAA house tournament in the same calendar year may be designated by notifying the KAA office.
- USA Softball Sanctioning Fee: Contact the KAA office to request USA sanctioning.
- Four Free April Pre-Season Practice Fields
 - o One time slot per team/per week. Practice fields are subject to availability.

- o All teams MUST register for practice fields at www.kwdaa.com
- o League Fee must be <u>PAID IN FULL</u>, and received in the KAA office to reserve preseason practice fields.

Opening Day for Leagues

- 6u-14u May 5
- 16u/18u May 26

League Registration

- 6u/8u Team or individual registrations accepted.
- KAA will provide assistance in forming 6u/8u teams.
- 10u-18u Team registrations only.
- All players/teams may access the discussion board at www.kwdaa.com/Discussion to locate players/teams in need of players.
- Age Eligibility Per Division:
- 6u Player may not turn 7 before January 1, 2021
- 8u- Player may not turn 9 before January 1, 2021
- 10u Player may not turn 11 before January 1, 2021
- 12u Player may not turn 13 before January 1, 2021
- 14u Player may not turn 15 before January 1, 2021
- 16u Player may not turn 17 before January 1, 2021
- 18u Player may not turn 19 before January 1, 2021

Pitching Distances:

- 6u Machine pitch (6u girls may play against 5u boys)
- 8u Machine pitch
- 10u Pitching Distance 35'
- 12u Pitching Distance 40'
- 14u, 16u, & 18u Pitching Distance 43'

Bracketing:

- "A" and "B" competitive levels for 10u, 12u, 14u, 16u & 18u divisions
- 6u & 8u are instructional divisions

League Timeframes:

- Wednesdays & Thursdays
- **6u** Single games, May thru early July
- **8u S**ingle games, May thru early July (Double-headers after school year if necessary)
- 10u Single games, May thru early July (Double-headers after school year if necessary)
- 12u-18u Double-headers, May thru early July
- **Premier (Invitation Only)** Double-headers, May July
- Women's Double-headers, May July. 14 games offered, 10 game guarantee

League Game Forfeits

Forfeits negatively impact players, parents, coaches and umpires, and are **not acceptable**.

- Team managers are expected to field a team to play their scheduled games.
- Only seven players are required to begin and finish league games.
- Teams can utilize fill-in players on days when they will be short provided that the player meets the age requirements, and is added to a KAA roster prior to the game being played.
- Team managers in the same division may agree to swap games if necessary.
- Game swaps must be agreed to by all parties involved, and approved in advance by the Division Supervisor and the KAA Softball Coordinator.

KAA League:

2019-2020 Credits: Teams intending to apply game credits towards the 2021 KAA League should email the KAA office at office@kwdaa.com to receive a coupon code to be used when registering. A coupon code is not necessary for teams wanting to apply their credits towards KAA house tournaments, however the office will need to be notified via email with the selected tournament.

Season Guarantee: Playing 8 games in total (league and free tournament) constitutes a complete season. At season's end, if you have not managed to play at least 8 games in total, KAA will offer a credit towards the 2021KAA Fall League, 2021KAA Fall Tourney or the 2022 KAA League. No cash refunds will be issued. There will be no standings maintained as this is a non-trophy league.

<u>Field Officials:</u> Umpire(s) will be supplied for 8u and older. The 6u & 8u machine-pitch divisions will require each team to provide one volunteer, preferably a coach, to operate the pitching machine. The volunteer must be at least 18 years old.

Rosters: Rosters are to be completed during the registration process, but can be amended during the season to add additional players. This must be done from the profile page of the person that registered the team. **Rosters must be on file in the KAA office in order for your team to be covered.**

KAA Website: Please utilize <u>www.kwdaa.com</u> to get the most up-to-date park information, league schedules and a list of the 2021KAA house tournaments. This website also hosts a discussion board for teams to advertise open positions, and for players to announce their availability to team managers. The KAA office does not maintain a list of coaches looking for players or players looking for teams.

Free Pre-Season Practice Fields:

- April 3- April 24
- League Fees must be "paid in full" to reserve your practice field & times.
- Practice fields are subject to availability.
- Practice sessions are 2 hours beginning at 6pm on weekdays and 8am on weekends
- One practice session per paid team per week time slot must be consistent all four weeks

- Practice dates cancelled due to inclement weather cannot be rescheduled
- The limited practice slots fill quickly, and are first come first served. No additional practice times will be scheduled.
- Email the office at office@kwdaa.com to secure a field
- The practice schedule will be posted on the east wall of the concession stand.

Park Rules

- No outside food or drinks; Team water is permitted

- No smoking inside the fenced area of the park, including vaping/e-cigarettes
- No beer allowed in the dugouts
- No bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc.
- No hitting balls into the fence (this includes wiffles)
- Teams and their spectators must follow all posted and/or published Covid-19 guidelines AT ALL TIMES

Be a Good Sport

Coaches are responsible for the conduct and sportsmanship of their players, assistant coaches and fans. Inappropriate or aggressive conduct towards an umpire, opposing coach, player or spectator OR failure to follow KAA Covid-19 Guidelines could result in the following:

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Ejection from the park
- 3. Forfeiture of game(s)
- 4. Incident report provided to USA for further disciplinary action

Concessions

KAA has put a significant amount of time and effort into making our concession stand one of the best in the St. Louis area. The focus is on providing fast, friendly service, with a large variety of delicious offerings that hungry fans want. A number of healthy options have been added over the past few years that have been a huge hit, so please check out the menu when you visit the park.

Since the concession stand is the financial life-blood of our facility, we must insist that WHEN THE STAND IS OPEN absolutely NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGE IS ALLOWED IN THE PARK.

Parking

- Parking on the grass in Green Tree Park across Marshall Road from KAA is no longer permitted by the City of Kirkwood. Vehicles parked in the grass will be ticketed and/or towed.
- Due to construction, the Family Golf Center located across Tree Court Industrial Blvd from KAA Field 8 will NOT allow parking on their lower gravel lot this season.
- Overflow parking is available in the lot behind the football field just east of KAA, and adjacent to Field 14
